

RESOLUTION NO. 65 - 1960

WHEREAS, pursuant to petition of more than ten per cent (10%) of the qualified electors residing on Orcas Island for the formation of a port district whose boundaries should be co-extensive with the boundaries of said Island, after hearing on the same, and pursuant to notice as required by law, an election was held within said Island on September 9, 1958, at which time the voters of the proposed district were asked to vote on the proposition:

"Shall a Port District to be known as the 'Port of Orcas' and containing all of the area of Orcas Island be created?"

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have canvassed the votes cast at the said election,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. That a majority of the voters who voted upon such proposition voted in favor of said Port District;
2. That the candidates receiving the highest number of votes for Port District Commissioners, each of whom resides in the district set out after his name, were as follows:

Clarence A. King	District No. 1
Kenneth D. Pearson	District No. 2
Elton W. Sawyer	District No. 3

3. That the Port of Orcas, with boundaries co-extensive with the boundaries of Orcas Island, be hereby established; and

4. That Clarence A. King, Kenneth D. Pearson and Elton W. Sawyer be and they are hereby declared to have been elected the first Commissioners thereof.
