Bicyclists, kayakers, and non-reserved vehicles must be ticketed and in line 20 minutes before departure.

Reservations Available

Vehicle reservations are available in the San Juan Islands:

- For all sailings to and from Sidney, BC
- Westbound: Anacortes to Friday Harbor, Orcas, Lopez and Shaw Islands
- Eastbound: Friday Harbor and Orcas islands to Anacortes*
- * Reservations are not available for interisland travel or eastbound travel from Lopez or Shaw islands to Anacortes.

Please note: Where available, reservations are recommended. Reservations must be made at least 2 hours in advance. Refer to your reservation confirmation page for the required arrival time at the terminal. See the Plan Your Trip section of this schedule for further information.



Westbound Notes

- Priority for Sidney, BC vehicles ticketed and in line no later than 8:00 a.m.
- Loads/unloads westbound traffic on eastbound sailing.
- No interisland vehicles loaded.

Eastbound Notes

- All passengers & their belongings boarding in Friday Harbor are subject to US Customs and Border Protection inspection.
- Loads/unloads eastbound traffic on westbound sailing.
- No interisland vehicles loaded.
- This sailing occasionally makes a prearranged stop at Lopez to pick up school vehicles and passengers only, which may delay the Anacortes arrival by approximately 10 min.
- The vessel will load, move briefly to the tieup slip, then sail to Orcas.
- The 11:35 a.m. interisland sailing from Friday Harbor stops at Shaw first, then continues to Orcas & Lopez.

International Travel

Proof of citizenship is required for entry into Canada and the United States. Passports, Enhanced Driver's Licenses and Nexus Cards are accepted for entrance into Canada for travelers 16 years old and older. Travelers entering the US are required to present a valid Passport, Passport Card or Enhanced Driver's License.

Vehicles and baggage are subject to inspection. Articles you bring into either country are subject to being taxed.

Please note: Individuals with felony or DUI convictions are routinely denied entry into Canada. Also, Canadian law prohibits individuals from bringing guns, mace, pepper spray and other personal defense products into Canada.

Traveling with Children

US and Canadian citizens who are 15 years old or younger are allowed to travel with just a copy of their birth certificate, as are teens between the ages of 16 and 18 if they are part of an adult-supervised school, religious, cultural or athletic group. If both birth parents are not traveling with children, you must have written authorization from the parent(s) along with a telephone number where they can be reached to verify the authorization or proof of custody. Failure to provide such evidence may prohibit the child from entry into Canada.
