FAA has recently stated below, when questioned about enplanements for 2021.

"legislation was passed ((Division L, Title IV, section 422 of Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 available at <a href="https://www.faa.gov/airports/crrsaa/">https://www.faa.gov/airports/crrsaa/</a>) allowing airports to receive passenger entitlements in fiscal years 2022 and 2023 based on either calendar year 2018 or 2019 enplanements, whichever is higher. As a result, it appears likely that ORS will qualify for passenger entitlements in FY2022."

We had over 10,000 for 2018 so we will get \$1M in funding for both years!
