



MANAGER & FACILITY REPORT 2023 FEBRUARY

- 1. EV Charging Stations** – A Draft Phase 1 Application for EV Charging stations has been presented by Bruce Benton. I am awaiting a comprehensive contact list identifying entities in agreement with the proposed project and would like to contact each prior to submitting.
- 2. Marine access opportunity** – The Deer Harbor Yacht Club is seeking interest in partnering on rebuilding a derelict dock for public use, located on a parcel adjacent to Deer Harbor Marina. Margaret will attend the public meeting this month to present to the Board.
- 3. BiPlane Hangar** – The removal project is nearly ready to put out to bid. We are looking at a May 1st start.
- 4. PAPI project** – The PAPI has been ordered and has a ship date for early April. We are looking at a May 1st start for this project, as well.
- 5. Airlift Northwest** – ALNW is interested in leasing a tie down space separate from the helipad to address the Boards concern over advantaged use, needs include electrical access and surveillance capabilities.
- 6. Wetland Maintenance** – Wetland Resources will be on island this coming week to monitor the status of the wetland mitigation and discuss the upcoming punch list. I am hoping to complete the work in-house through a series of work parties as the groundwater recedes.
- 7. Drainage Study** – WHPacific/NV5 and the FAA continue to update the Drainage Study to include a Flood Plain Analysis.
