MEETING MINUTES (DRAFT version 20Apr2025)

CALL TO ORDER: [00:00]

- Chair Kartiganer called the meeting to order at 5:00pm.
- A quorum of commissioners Kartiganer, Triplett, and Schuh attended in person, and Laursen and Hamilton attended via video. Staff present were Long and Ihlenfeldt.

AGENDA AMENDMENTS

• A couple of items were proposed, but these were covered during the regular course of the meeting in Old Business.

MONTHLY BUSINESS

- 1. Previous Minutes [00:05]
- a) 02/24/25 Regular Meeting Minutes
 - Hamilton moved, Schuh seconded to accept the minutes. There was a discussion about the propriety of listing or not listing who made Yeas or Nays. Standard Rules are to not list names. Motion was approved with four Yeas and one Abstention.
- 2. Approval of Vouchers [00:10]

 - Hamilton moved, Kartinganer seconded, and all vouchers were approved with four Yeas and one Nav.

MONTHLY REPORTS

Manager's Report [00:11]

- Long discussed fuel supplies and deliveries, the next "short load" will be in July. Pricing at \$6.85/galloon. It was noted that Friday Harbor fuel was more expensive and Anacortes less expensive, except that they didn't have any to sell.
- Eastside hangar drainage improvements made by Public Works and the ESWD worked well during last storm.
- Nickel Brothers moved a house from the beach across the airport on the night of March 5th. It shut the airport for about 3 hours. Nichol Brothers said that they intend to purchase rock next time, with our approval, to make the transition on the south side to the Mt. Baker Road easier.

2. Financial Report [00:16]

- DOR Sales Tax Update tabled.
- Still trying to get the various County agencies and bank to talk to each other.
- Currently working on the audit.
- Ihlenfeldt is working to create AR reporting in QuickBooks (QB). TTF invoices were emailed in January. Everyone is paid up for all previous years.
- Triplett requested an AR report next time for all outstanding invoices.
- DOR is still going in circles on permissions, but a "Officers' Change Form" was submitted so maybe some progress. Meeting with DOR again this week to keep working on it.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Port/ESWD Interlocal [00:21]

• Long reported that the Interlocal Agreement was signed by him and delivered to the ESWD for their Board to take action.

2. PAPI Flight Check [00:22]

- Long reported on update John Schute. We have perhaps three options:
 - o A new PAPI from the current manufacturer that actually meet FAA standards
 - Researching two other manufacturers
 - FAA agent Parker [sp?] suggests changing the horizontal approach profile to create more distance from obstacles.
- Triplett asked whether the FAA would want to pursue this on our behalf, since they
 have more clout? Long responded that the FAA is helping, and that otherwise the
 PAPI either works or it doesn't and the manufacturer must provide FAA certifiable
 equipment.

- Triplett asked about current safety issues. Long responded that the previous PAPIs are still operational so no concern about safety.
- Triplett asked PAPI warranty. Long will find out.
- Laursen asked about the certification basis of the new PAPI. Long responded that certification happens after installation.
- Laursen asked why the FAA is not more concerned about the four-year delay in the installation. Hamilton asked about the effectiveness of the Engineering company.
- Triplett asked about a paper trail of the problems that have been encountered. Long responded that there is a huge email "paper" trail.

3. Projects and Planning:

Runway Project [00:37]

- Mason Parks gave a runway project update
 - He again shared the timeline. Currently at final stage of design.
 - The planned airport closure is now planned for September 2026, after Labor Day.
 - o There will always be weather risks.
- The engineers determined that milling was not preferred, and a thorough cleaning and surface prep was best to preserve the existing integrity of the runway. The same ~2 inches of new asphalt will be overlayed. Taxis and other areas are planned for seal-coating. 40% overlay and 60% sealcoating, but this could change with actual bid amounts.
- Still some risk in the final amount of the FAA grant.
- When asked about leveling, Mason explained that existing cracks will be filled and that the asphalt will level out the surface, but no extraordinary efforts will be made to change the profile of the runway.

Vierthaler Property [00:52]

- CSD (our lawyers) have given us recommendations on how to remove the house and related structure legally.
- Two bids have been received for demolition of the house including hangar, foundation, and trees that are in the ROFA. To be discussed in Executive Session at the next meeting. An appraisal for the current value of the building is also needed.
- It was reiterated that the FAA will pay for demolition or alternative means of removal and ground restoration up the demolition bid amounts.
- The Commissioners discussed various aspects and options, including keeping the hangar and possible installation of new hangars. The appointed Committee will read

- the CSD recommendation, gather other information, and come back to the Commission with recommendations.
- Long and the Commissioners discussed the rental of the Vierthaler hangar to a local pilot. Long used the rental rate of a twin tiedown spot as a comp. Hamilton chastised Triplett on his letter to the other Commissioners concerning this matter, calling both the threat of going to authorities and also the request to obtain the hangar for his own use wildly inappropriate. Kartiganer expounded on this including that it is waste of everyone's time.

EV Charger Project [01:22]

• Long gave a brief update on the various sites that have been installed and will be installed, including the two level 2s at the airport.

Bi-Plane Hangar Roof-Bids [01:25]

• Laursen talked to several local painters who responded that they were not interested. Long said that he has one lead he intends to follow up on.

By-Laws Time change [01:26]

 Hamilton moved, Kartiganer seconded a motion to move our regular monthly meeting from 5:00pm to 4:00pm, still on the same fourth Monday. After discussion of the pros and cons and the history of the time and date change from Thursdays, the motion passed with three Yeas and two Nays.

NEW BUSINESS

No new business.

PUBLIC ACCESS [01:34]

- Allan questioned why a horizontal change to the approach would make a difference for the PAPI. Long explained.
- Fant suggested that we think of the Vierthaler house as FAA property, not ours, and stop ourselves from trying to turn it into a hangar. Just demolish it or move it.
- Allan commented that the Vierthaler hangar includes a kitchen and other amenities, and could not be easily detached from the house.
